# ***HORSES***

**Judging commences at 8.15am. The measuring for Temporary Measuring Certificates will commence at 7.15am until 8.15am. Please note this is for local competitors living within the show boundary who attend this show only. No other exceptions will be made.**

- Some Judges yet to be confirmed at the time of print, will be listed on the updated schedule available on our website.

- Judges decision shall be final.

- Judges may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances.

The Horse Section of the Courtenay A & P Show adheres to the rules of the RAS.. For full rules refer [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz), Email: enquiries@ras.org.nz. It is recommended that all competitors study the latest RAS rules.

The following sections are Horse of the Year Qualifiers – Group A, B , C & D Hacks, Group A, B, C & D Ponies, Lead Rein, First Ridden, Standardbred, Rider and Pinto & Gypsy Cob Classes. The Cob and Hunter Jumping Sections do not qualify for HOY.

**CONDITIONS:** This show supports the **RAS "Yellow Card"** system for inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook. The RAS Affiliated Show and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the Show). Any penalty is suspended until the possible new offences have been processed. Full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website as above.

**DRUG TESTING - Forbidden Substance -** Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems. The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Forbidden Substances apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible's risk. Your signature on the entry form denotes acceptance of these conditions.

**AREARS -** No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other show/event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

**RAS RESOLUTION PROCESS -** The full process can be found on the RAS website. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the Show. If the matter is in regards to an RAS Official, the Show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner.

- The Committee reserves the right to object to and /or remove from the grounds any person being heavy handed or harsh to a horse or pony.
- The members in attendance may remove any horse or pony from the ring, if in their opinion, it is a danger to other competitors.
- No prizes to be awarded if the Judge considers the horse unsound. Judges are directed to award prizes only to animals, which they consider free from hereditary unsoundness.

**STALLIONS AND COLTS** - Please note stallions are permitted in Hunter Jumping. All other classes to be mare or gelding unless otherwise specified.

- All stallions and colts (with the exception of Miniature horses, Shetland yearlings and foals) must be shown in a bit.
- A Steward will order any stallion/colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion/colt's owner/exhibitor/competitor.
- It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows/Events at all times. The rider/handler must also wear two RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at Shows/Events when outside the showing ring. 'S' badges to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; armbands and vests from RAS Head Office.

## **GENERAL RULES**

- Names of horses to be given. In stating age of horse the year to count from 1st August.
- All riders to be under the age stipulated as from 1st August. Open pony exhibits (also see CDE 12 h) must be ridden by riders under seventeen years of age.
- In all classes where height is specified 5mm will be allowed for shoes, and competitors must carry height certificates. Certificates of Height - Life and Annual, from Ellesmere, Ashburton, Northern and Canterbury A&Ps will be accepted.
- Refunds: 75% refund upon production of a medical or veterinary certificate. Substitutions accepted – contact Secretary.
- Registered partnerships and leases are acceptable but proof may be required.
- All Hackneys, Non Hackneys and Miniature Horses in harness are invited to parade just prior to the Horse Parade.
- Competitors may be disqualified if not ready when called. Consideration cannot be given to riders where judging times in different groups conflict. Entering in different sections is at your own risk.

## **HEALTH AND SAFETY - HELMETS**

All riders, including harness drivers, must wear protective headgear which meets approved hat/helmet standards. Standards can be found at <http://www.ras.org.nz> – equestrian. Helmet compliance is the responsibility of the rider/parent. The Courtenay A&P Association does not accept responsibility for injuries resulting from the use of non-compliant helmets.

## **DEFINITION OF NOVICE**

- A Novice exhibit or rider, is one that has yet to win six (6) classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A&P Show/Event. Once you have achieved six wins in Confirmation (and this includes

Ladies and Gent's classes) and /or Paced and Mannered classes, you can no longer enter in Novice classes in that category.

- Novice wins to be counted at time of Show.

- If Horse/Pony is upgraded, entry to another class is permitted or entry fee can be reclaimed. Inquiries to the Secretary.

- Novice Horse & Ponies to be shown in **snaffle bits** only. See RAS website for diagram.

- Novice may enter open classes.

- As District Classes are restricted they do not count as Open Novice wins. A win in a district/novice (no wins) does not count for Open Novice Classes

- Adults may ride in Novice Pony Classes on the flat, with the exception of Novice Pony Stallions.

- Novice Pony Stallions must be led or ridden by a rider 14 years and over.

- Open Pony Stallions must be ridden by a rider 14, 15 or 16 years of age, led handlers must be 14 years and over.

- Riders in horse rings (exhibits over 148cm) must be 12 years and over.

- Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a rider 17 years of age or older.

## **DISTRICT**

- Exhibitor and Rider must reside in the district, between the Rakaia and Waimakariri Rivers, and west of the Main South, Dawsons and Chattertons Roads.
